Dear Merchant

The husky bucks program enables UConn students and employees to put money on their ID card (the Husky One Card) and use their ID as a form of payment instead of cash or credit card. Currently students and employees use their husky bucks to purchase goods and services in many locations on the Storrs and the regional campuses.

It is the mission of the One Card Office to expand the use of the ID to as many places as possible. For this reason we look forward to our partnership with the local businesses in enabling husky bucks to be accepted off-campus.

In order to connect to our system UConn will provide the merchant with a programmed verifone tranz380x2 which requires an analog line. The cost of the reader and printer is \$200 and the merchant will either need to install an analog line or use their current fax line. UConn will also provide daily e-mails of sales as well as a weekly report of total sales for the week. The merchant will be reimbursed weekly. Please note that due to the size of our office, support coverage will be from 8am-4pm, Monday-Friday.

To participate merchants will need to either mail or fax us the following:

- a signed contract
- an application form
- an additional information form
- an ACH form with a copy of a voided check
- a logo & a website link (if you want it on our website)

You will also find special notice SN 2003 (1) which describes tax exemptions for businesses accepting prepaid meal plan cards from schools for sales of food and beverages. University of Connecticut students and staff are tax exempted when buying food and beverages (except alcohol) with husky bucks at off-campus businesses.
